COVID-19

Please see attached a letter from the Department of Education to all parents/guardians of primary school children in regard to antigen testing and Covid-19 symptoms in schools. From Monday 29th of November, if you receive a positive PCR COVID-19 test result for your child, please contact me immediately by calling the school number or directly at gortnationalschool@gmail.com. I will then contact the parents of the other children in your child's pod, to give details of how they can order free antigen tests for their children using a Freephone number. I will not share any personal information relating to any other child with parents.

A reminder that the most important way to protect against any onward spread of infection is that **if your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, including a new cough, shortness of breath, high temperature, sore throat, they should self-isolate at home and you should book a COVID-19 PCR test for them. Children who have symptoms should not use antigen tests, they should stay at home and organise a PCR test for Covid-19.**

Absence Notes

Following any pupil absence from school please inform the school by putting a note in your child's diary of the dates and reason for the absence so that we may record it on our online roll system.

Also, all children returning to school after an absence must have a completed **Return to Educational Facility Parental Declaration Form**. Every pupil has one of these forms in their school bag.
